The tools in Photoshop can be used for a wide range of tasks For example, you can use the Pencil and Brush tools along with new erodible brush tips to simulate sketching or painting Use the shape tools to create rectangles and ovals, and use the Text tool to create text Use the selection tools to select areas by shape or color

Place a photo above a background image

In the upper left corner of Photoshop, click File then Place embedded Use the options on the left side of the File open dialogue box to get to a location such as the Desktop, Downloads, flash drive, or hard drive where you have your foreground image saved Click on the picture you want as

your foreground to highlight it, and then click Place
